### Timeline of Events: A Whirlwind

- Discussions began August 2021
- First meeting of founding members in October 2021
- Received articles of incorporation in Ohio and submitted 501c3 paperwork in November 2021
- Developed ASON logo in November 2021
- ASON website created in December 2021
- Submitted editorial on the inception of ASON to JON in January 2022
- Negotiated JON subscription in January 2022

.....And announced creation + welcomed members in January 2022





### Membership Requirements: Some Bumps in the Road

- We did away with requirement for scholarly activity based on feedback from you
- Yearly fee of \$150
  - Note that \$80 will go to JON as part of our negotiations
  - Over time, anticipate free membership for trainees
- Must attend an ASON meeting in-person or virtually at least once every 3 years



Membership

- Application process simplified on website
- Safe/secure option through Chase Bank for paying via credit card
- Foreign exchange challenges for some who have difficulty paying via credit card
- So far, 81 applications
- 62 approved/paid members over 5 continents!
- Continued outreach through word-ofmouth and social media
- Welcome feedback and ideas for improving outreach

## Leadership in ASON

- President(s) holds office for 1 year
- Secretary and treasurer hold office for 2 years
- Committee heads elected every 2 years
- Committee members rotate every 2 years







## Committees



### Selection Process: Committee Heads

- Must be a member
- Must submit 1-page rationale with qualifications
- For research and positions statement committees, must have some research experience
- Can submit applications to head multiple committees but can only head 1 committee at a time
- Voted on by founding members this year, but in the future, by all members
- Due date for applications: March 5, 2022



### Selection Process: Committee Members

- Must be a member
- Must submit 1/2-page rationale with qualifications
- For research and positions statement committees, must have some research experience
- Can submit applications to be a member of multiple committees but please consider time commitment
- Voted on by founding members this year, but in the future, by all members
- Due date for applications: March 5, 2022



Committee Requirements Must have meetings at least 4x/year, with minutes circulated to all members for transparency

Education, research, and position statement committees will have cochairs

Committee heads and members will serve 2-year terms

### Website Committee

- No requirement for scholarly activity
- One chair
- Up to 10 committee participants
- Responsibilities:
  - Beautify the website
  - Add content
  - Maintain a blog
  - Create webpage with list of chemotherapies and their side effects

## Social Media

- No requirement for scholarly activity
- Single chair
- Up to 10 committee members
- Maintain Twitter account, LinkedIn, Facebook, etc.
- Spread the word about upcoming events







### **Event Planning**

- Co-chairs: no research background needed
- Up to 10 committee members
- Identifying and developing sponsorship for events
- Plan any in-person or virtual ASON meetings for all members
- Responsible for planning yearly ASON meeting prior to Onconephrology Symposium



### Research



Co-chairs: must have some background in research

Up to 15 members



Work with website committee to keep a spreadsheet of potential projects only accessible to members



Help foster and oversee research collaborations



### Position Statements

Nephrologists have often been excluded from the development of guidelines for kidney-related issues in cancer patients

Co-chairs: must have research experience
Up to 10 members

Over 2 years, work towards generating one set of guidelines

Co-chairs who must have some background in education or research



Host monthly educational sessions

Journal clubs
Clinicopathologic
conferences
